

- 1. No one under the age of 15 can play Bingo unless accompanied by an adult.
- 2. A MASTER GAME BOOK (9 TV 10 page) must be purchased to be eligible to play any game on the program; including special games.
- 3. Players are responsible to check books before start of play; 10 pages per book.
- 4. Bingo paper, sheets or booklets must not be cut or altered in any way.
- 5. House is not responsible for unplayed, missing, lost or damaged pages or special cards after purchase.
- 6. Players must be playing his/her own bingo package or specials to be seated at a bingo table.
- 7. All bingo cards in play must be furnished by the organization conducting the bingo, and may not be taken out of the building.
- 8. No refunds will be given on unused packages or specials once bingo has begun.
- 9. House reserves the right to refuse entrance.
- 10. House reserves the right to cancel due to bad weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- 11. House reserves the right to pay by cheque.
- 12. It is the player's responsibility to raise their hand/card and call "Bingo" loud enough to stop play.
- 13. Should the caller have a ball in their hand and bingo is called, that number will NOT be called unless it is a false bingo.
- 14. Once bingo has been declared, no further numbers will be called pending confirmation of bingo.
- 15. Once the game has been declared CLOSED, no more bingos will be accepted for that game.
- 16. In case of multiple winners, all prizes are split equally. (no Minimum payout)
- 17. If a player has a multiple win, it is the responsibility of that player to bring it to the attention of the checker prior to the game being closed.
- 18. Breakopen tickets must be cashed on the same day purchased.
- 19. No one under the age of 18 is allowed to buy or sell Breakopen tickets.
- 20. All cell phones must be turned off or on vibrate during bingo play.
- 21. All staff/volunteers other than the caller are allowed to play bingo.
- 22. Complaints or disputes will be directed to the Management. Any problems with the decision of the Management can be directed to the Liquor and Gaming Authority of Manitoba.
