### PREP TIME: 10 MINUTES | COOK TIME: 35 MINUTES | SERVES 6



#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 Medium Large (3-lb) Butternut Squash
- 1 Large Yellow Onion
- 3 Cloves Garlic
- 1 tbsp Chopped Fresh Sage
- 1/2 tbsp Minced Fresh Rosemary
- 1 tsp Grated Fresh Ginger
- 2 tablespoons Extra-virgin olive oil
- 3 4 cups Vegetable Broth

Salt/Ground Black Pepper to taste Add chopped parsley to serve

- 1. Heat the oil in a large pot over medium heat. Add onion, salt, several grinds of fresh pepper and saute until soft (5-8 min). Add squash and cook until it begins to soften, stirring occassionally (8-10min).
- 2. Add garlic, sage, rosemary, and ginger. Stir and cook 30 seconds to 1 minute, until fragrant, then add 3 cups of the broth. Bring to a boil, cover, and reduce heat to simmer. Cook until squash is tender (20-30 min).
- 3. Let cool slightly and pour soup in a blender (working in batches), and blend until smooth. If too thick, add up to 1 cup more of broth and blend. Season to taste and serve with parsley. Enjoy!
